# MOTION FOR LEAVE TO PROCEED IN FORMA PAUPERIS

Pursuant to Rule 39 of the Rules of the Supreme Court of the United States, the petitioner requests leave to file the attached petition for a writ of certiorari without prepayment of costs and to proceed in forma pauperis. This relief is warranted because during all phases of the proceedings below, the petitioner has been found to be indigent and counsel has been appointed to represent him. On September 7, 2022, present counsel was appointed to represent him in the Cambridge District Court (2152 CR 000735) where she filed a post-conviction motion to set aside the verdict. A copy of the relevant portion of the docket is attached as Appendix A. On April 18, 2024, the Massachusetts Supreme Judicial Court allowed the petitioner's motion to waive the filing fees on grounds of indigency (SJC-13592). A copy of the relevant portion of the docket is attached as Exhibit B. On April 4, 2025, the Committee for Public Counsel Services which assigns counsel for indigent individuals, authorized present counsel to represent the petitioner before this Court to file a Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus (NAC #D28177936). A copy of the correspondence is attached as Appendix C.

The relevant provisions of Massachusetts law pertaining to the appointment of counsel are G.L. c. 211D, §§2 and 5, Rule 8 of the Massachusetts Rules of Criminal Procedure and Supreme Judicial Court Rule 3:10.

**WHEREFORE**, Mr. Zemene respectfully requests that this Court grant his motion to proceed *in forma pauperis*.
