MOTION TO PROCEED IN FORMA PAUPERIS

***THIS IS A CAPITAL CASE
WITH AN EXECUTION SCHEDULED FOR
TUESDAY, JUNE 10, 2025, AT 6:00 P.M.***

Petitioner Anthony Floyd Wainwright moves pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 39 to proceed in forma pauperis (IFP) pursuant in connection with his application for a stay of execution and petition for a writ of certiorari. Mr. Wainwright is an indigent prisoner on Florida's death row with a scheduled execution of June 10, 2025, at 6:00 p.m.

Mr. Wainwright was previously granted IFP status by each state and federal court in which he has challenged this conviction and sentence, including: the Florida

Supreme Court; the Circuit Court of the Third Judicial Circuit in and for Hamilton County, Florida; the United States District Court for the Middle District of Florida; and the Eleventh Circuit Court of Appeals. This Court allowed Mr. Wainwright to proceed under IFP status in previous certiorari-stage proceedings. *See, e.g.*, No. 23-6737.

Mr. Wainwright requests that IFP status be granted.
