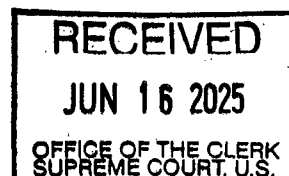

I, Donald Perry, pro se Petitioner hereby certify, pursuant to


