Stephen L. Borrello, Chief Judge Pro Tem, acting under MCR 7.203(F)(1), orders:

The claim of appeal is DISMISSED for lack of jurisdiction. The June 21, 2024 order denying the motion to set aside default is not a final order appealable by right. MCR 7.203(A)(1); MCR 7.202(6)(a). Specifically, the June 21, 2024 order is not the first order to dispose of all claims and adjudicate the rights and liabilities of all the parties. MCR 7.202(6)(a)(1). Moreover, assuming without concluding that the May 30, 2024 order granting the amended motion for entry of default and default judgment is a final order appealable by right, the claim of appeal is untimely filed from the May 30, 2024 order. MCR 7.204(A). It was not filed within 21 days of entry of the May 30, 2024 order and no motion for postjudgment relief of the May 30, 2024 order was filed within the initial 21-day appeal period. MCR 7.204(A)(1)(a) and (d). Dismissal is without prejudice to whatever other relief may be available consistent with the court rules.


