***Agudas Chasidei Chabad of United States v. Russian Federation, No. 24-909***

Dear Mr. Harris:

I write on behalf of Tenex-USA, Incorporated (“Tenex-USA”), Respondent in the above-listed case. On December 3, 2024, Petitioner Agudas Chasidei Chabad of United States (“Chabad”) filed an application for a 60-day extension of time to file its petition for a writ of certiorari, from December 22, 2024, to February 20, 2025, which the Court granted on December 5, 2025. Chabad filed its petition for a writ of certiorari on February 20, 2025, and the Court docketed the petition on February 24, 2025. Any response to Chabad’s petition is currently due by March 26, 2025.

Pursuant to Supreme Court Rules 15.3 and 30.4, Tenex-USA respectfully requests a 30-day extension of time—*i.e.*, until April 25, 2025—to submit its response to Chabad’s petition. This extension is necessary because counsel for Tenex-USA has significant client-related international travel obligations and several intervening filing deadlines in other litigation and international arbitration matters during the relevant period. This is Tenex-USA’s first request to extend time.

Undersigned counsel has conferred with counsel for Chabad, who consents to the requested extension.
