I write on behalf of Respondents Edward Christopher Sheeran, Sony/ATV Music Publishing LLC, Atlantic Recording Corporation, BDi Music Ltd., Bucks Music Group Ltd., The Royalty Network, Inc., David Platz Music (USA) Inc., Amy Wadge and Jake Gosling (collectively, "Respondents").

The Court docketed the petition for a writ of certiorari in the above-captioned case on March 13, 2025. Absent a request for an extension of time, Respondents' response, if Respondents determine to submit a response absent request therefor by the Court, is currently due on April 14, 2025. Because we believe that petitioner has materially misrepresented the bases for the lower courts' decisions, we do presently contemplate bringing this information to the attention of the Court.

Due to other commitments and in accordance with this Court's Rules 15.3 and 30.4, Respondents respectfully request a 30-day extension, to and including Wednesday, May 14, 2025, to file their response to the petition. As stated, the requested extension has been necessitated by pre-existing discovery obligations and motion deadlines that both I and my colleagues on this matter have in other cases. Further, because we represent nine separate respondents, coordinating their joint response will take a reasonable amount of time.
