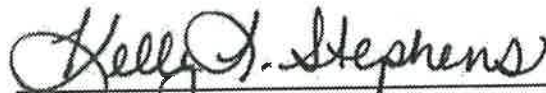

Rickey Benson petitions for rehearing en banc of this court's order entered on January 16, 2025, denying leave to proceed in forma pauperis on appeal. The petition was initially referred to this panel, on which the original deciding judge does not sit. After review of the petition, this panel issued an order announcing its conclusion that the original application was properly denied. The petition was then circulated to all active members of the court, none of whom requested a vote on the suggestion for an en banc rehearing. Pursuant to established court procedures, the panel now denies the petition for rehearing en banc. Unless Benson pays the \$605 filing fee to the district court within 30 days of the entry of this order, this appeal will be dismissed for want of prosecution.
