MOTION FOR A 30 DAY ENLARGEMENT OF TIME TO FILE PETITION FOR A WRIT OF CERTIORARI

Pro se Petitioner Stephen Aguiar respectfully moves the Court for a 30 day enlargement of time from June 9, 2025 to July 9, 2025 to file a petition for writ of certiorari in connection with sought review of the Second Circuit's January 22, 2025 summary order denying the Petitioner's appeal and March 11, 2025 order denying the Petitioner's timely-filed petition for panel rehearing with suggestion for rehearing en banc.
