### MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE WRIT OF CERTIORARI AND REQUEST FOR APPOINTMENT OF COUNSEL

Petitioner Terry Duane Qualls, pro se, moves this Honorable Court for an extension of time to file his Writ of Certiorari. Petitioner is currently incarcerated at the Federal Correction Facility in Oakdale, Louisiana, with limited access to legal resources. Initially, Petitioner intended to file this Writ of Certiorari pro se; however, given the stringent filing and paper copy requirements, Petitioner prefers to have the assistance of counsel.

Petitioner has a meritorious claim that his appeal was not barred by his plea agreement's appeal waiver and that the sentence imposed by the Eastern District of Arkansas in case number 3:23-CR-32-1 was contrary to established law. Despite an assurance by the district court judge on the record that Petitioner was preserving his right to appeal the application of the Armed Career Criminal Act enhancement on the grounds that the state law applicable to Petitioner's prior offenses included hemp in the definition of marijuana and thus those offenses could not serve as the predicate offenses for the application of the enhancement, the Government moved to dismiss Petitioner's appeal (Case No. 25-1276), which the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Eighth Circuit granted without a written opinion. The mandate was issued on March 24, 2025.
