APPLICATION FOR A SIXTY- DAY EXTENSION OF TIME IN WHICH TO FILE PETITION FOR A WRIT OF CERTIORARI

To the Honorable Brett M. Kavanaugh, Associate Justice of the United States Supreme Court, and Circuit Justice for the Eighth Circuit:

1. Pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 13.5, 22, and 30, Applicant Ricky Durham ("Durham") respectfully requests a 60-day extension of time, up to and including January 31, 2025, to file a petition for a writ of certiorari to the Supreme Court of the United States, seeking review of the Missouri Supreme Court's denial of habeas relief in *Durham v. Adams*, No. SC100678 (Mo). The Missouri Supreme Court denied habeas relief on September 3, 2024. A copy of the order is attached as Appendix A. The jurisdiction of this Court will be invoked under 28

- U.S.C. § 1257, and the time to otherwise file a petition for certiorari will otherwise expire on December 2, 2024. This Application for Extension of Time is timely filed on October 18, 2024, more than ten days prior to the date on which the time for filing the petition is to expire.
- 2. This is applicant's first request for an extension of time to file a response. Good cause exists for the requested extension of the December 2, 2024, deadline, and a substantial amount of work remains to be done in order to submit an adequate petition for writ of certiorari.
- a. Counsel was only recently retained in his matter and needs the additional time to prepare the petition.
- b. Counsel has a number of scheduled hearings over the next two months in post-conviction cases that will take a up a substantial amount of his time. See Estes v. State, No. 23DU-CC00053 (Dunklin Co. Cir.) (evidentiary hearing scheduled for November 6, 2024); Scherrer v. State; No. 23SF-CC00232 (St. Francois Co. Cir.) (evidentiary hearing scheduled November 8, 2024); McLaurie v. State, No. 2011-CC00210 (St. Charles Co. Cir.) (evidentiary hearing scheduled for December 9, 2024). In addition, counsel also has deadlines for, among other things, appellate briefs during this time period. See Rush v. State, No. ED112554 (Mo. App. E.D.) (appellate brief due October 24, 2024); Keathley

v. State, No. SD38615 (Mo. App. S.D.) (appellate brief due November 11, 2024);

and Huskey v. State, No. SD38387 (Mo. App. S.D.) (appellate brief due November

25, 2024).

An extension of time would better enable preparation of a petition c.

that would be most helpful to the Court.

d. This request is made in good faith and for the reasons set forth above,

and not for the purposes of delay.

Respondent does not object to this extension of time request. On e.

October 18, 2024, counsel for applicant emailed counsel for respondent, Patrick

Logan, Assistant Missouri Attorney General, to inform him of the request for an

extension of time and requested that he advise whether respondent would oppose

this motion. Counsel for applicant received an email back from Mr. Logan stating

that respondent will not oppose applicant's request.

WHEREFORE, Applicant respectfully requests that an order be entered

extending the time to file a petition for a writ of certiorari for 60 days, to and

including January 31, 2025.
