The last ruling of the Supreme Court of Florida in this case was made on 11/26/2024 (copy attached) when *The Supreme Court of Florida* denied my *Motion to Reinstate* my case. The deadline for filing my *Petition for a Writ of Certiorari* is February 24th, 2025. I am asking that I be allowed 60 days, until April 30th, 2025, to file the *Petition for a Writ of Certiorari*. I will try to file it sooner than that. I filed a *Petition for a Writ of Certiorari* in a related case for SC2024-1368. Both cases grew out of appeals in the same case.

I am proceeding pro se, and should be given every opportunity to prove my case.
