APPLICATION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE A PETITION FOR A WRIT OF CERTIORARI TO THE UNITED STATES COURT OF APPEALS FOR THE SEVENTH CIRCUIT

To the Honorable Amy Coney Barrett, Associate Justice of the Supreme Court and Circuit Justice for the Seventh Circuit:

1. Pursuant to Supreme Court Rules 13.5, 22, and 30, Applicant Benjamin Adams respectfully requests a 60-day extension of time, up to and including July 7, 2025, to file a petition for a writ of certiorari to the United States Court of Appeals for the Seventh Circuit, seeking review of that court's decision in *Adams v. Reagle*, 91 F.4th 880 (7th Cir. 2024). The Seventh Circuit issued its decision on January 30, 2024, and denied a timely rehearing petition on February 7, 2025. These orders are attached as Appendix A and Appendix B, respectively. The jurisdiction of this Court will be invoked under 28 U.S.C. § 1254(1), and the time to file a petition for a writ of certiorari will otherwise expire on May 8, 2025. This Application is timely because it has been filed on March 26, 2025, more than ten days prior to the date on which the time for filing the petition is to expire.

2. Applicant has good cause for an extension of time. Applicant's Counsel of Record has extensive professional obligations over the coming months, including a reply brief on the merits due April 11 in *Parrish v. United States* (No. 24-275), an oral argument on April 21 in *Parrish v. United States* (No. 24-275), an oral argument on May 7 in *Beny v. University of Michigan* (6th Cir. No. 24-1647), a response brief due May 26 in *General Electric Co. v. Boilmaker-Blacksmith National Pension Trust* (8th Cir. 25-1442), and an opening brief due May 27, 2025 in *Puris v. TikTok Inc.* (2d Cir. No. 25-322). In light of these and other competing commitments, the quality of the petition would greatly benefit from an extension of time.

WHEREFORE, Applicant respectfully requests that an order be entered extending the time to file a petition for a writ of certiorari for 60 days, to and including July 7, 2025.
