I,

hereby affirmatively declare ,

depose and say:

I am a veteran, Pursuant to the Universal Military Training and Service Act, I enlisted into the United States Air Force as a airman basic on June 3, 1969. I served continuously with top secret clearance, firearms expert-special category as Honorary President body guard of Richard M. Nixon, U.S. President until August 3, 1973 on which date I was honorably discharged AFSC-No.

Thereafter on 05/08/2023, I instituted this suit in the United STATE DISTRICT COURT for the District of Columbia, to reestablish my employment rights under the provisions of 38 USC §4302.

The District Court denied forma pauperis status contrary to their District Court allotment Rule, afterwards a United States Court of Appeals denied forma pauperis status contrary therein to other United States Courts of Appeals judgments relative to . herein and contrary to movants unenumerated 9th Amendment rights to redress my cause of action as a United States veteran suing under any provision of the law exempting veterans from the prepayment of fees, or court costs.

I now wish to file a petition for certiorari, seeking appeal review of this judgment as blind veteran.
