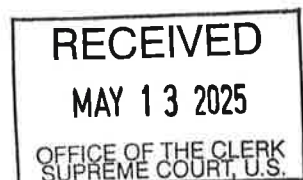
MOTION TO PROCEED AS A VETERAN


