On consideration of the papers filed in this appeal and review of the short record,

IT IS ORDERED that this appeal is DISMISSED because it is frivolous.

In this case, appellant seeks to appeal the denial of his motion for a declaratory judgment seeking to dismiss an indictment on a sovereign immunity theory under the Foreign Sovereign Immunities Act. Denials of requests to dismiss indictments are not typically appealable before entry of final judgment, see United States v. Schock, 891 F.3d 334, 338 (7th Cir. 2018), but to the extent denial of immunity in a criminal case is a collateral order, appellant's assertion of immunity is frivolous. See United States v. Benabe, 654 F.3d 753, 767 (7th Cir. 2011) ("We have repeatedly rejected ... theories of individual sovereignty, immunity from prosecution, and their ilk."); see also Turkiye Halk Bankasi A.S. v. United States, 598 U.S. 264, 272 (2023) (holding Foreign Sovereign Immunities Act does not provide immunity in criminal proceedings). A frivolous assertion of immunity does not invoke this court's appellate jurisdiction even if it might otherwise be available. See Apostol v. Gallion, 870 F.2d 1335, 1339 (7th Cir. 1989).
