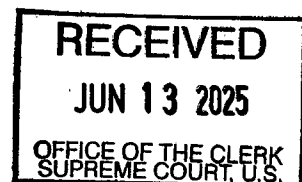

Pro se prisoner Plaintiff Joshua Martinez sued the United States.
