Please be advised of a scrivener's error regarding dates in the above-referenced application for an extension of the deadline to file a petition for a writ of certiorari, which was filed on Friday July 3, 2025. The application is timely, but the scrivener's error regarding dates may cause unintended confusion. The application mistakenly states that "[u]nless extended, the time to file a petition for a writ of certiorari will expire on *July 5, 2024*." App. 1 (emphasis added). With correction, the application should state that "[u]nless extended, the time to file a petition for a writ of certiorari will expire on July 15, 2025." The application is therefore timely because it was filed on July 3, 2025, more than ten days before July 15, 2025. For these reasons, the Applicant respectfully requests that the Court take this correction into consideration when addressing the application.
