#### CONSENT MOTION TO AMEND CASE MANAGEMENT ORDER NO. 2

Delaware respectfully moves for an extension of time to file its opposition to the State of New Jersey's Motion to Strike Delaware's Issues of Fact Nos. 1, 2, 6, 8, and 9 and to Preclude Discovery on These Issues. As mentioned in the February 23, 2006 email from David Frederick to the Special Master and counsel for New Jersey, this extension is necessary and appropriate for adequate briefing of the issues presented and in view of Mr. Frederick's Supreme Court argument calendar, among other obligations.<sup>1</sup>
