CASE MANAGEMENT ORDER NO. 13

1. The Special Master issued Case Management Order No. 12, setting the deadlines for filing any dispositive motions and oppositions thereto and setting the page limits for any such filings.

2. Delaware has now moved to extend the page and time limits for such filings and permit the filing of reply memoranda associated with those motions. New Jersey has consented, in part, to Delaware's request.

3. Good cause having been shown, Delaware's motion is granted in part, as set forth herein:

a. The deadline for filing of any dispositive motions with incorporated memoranda of law remains December 22, 2006.

b. The deadline for filing memoranda in opposition to any such dispositive motions is extended from January 12, 2007 to and including February 1, 2007.

c. The deadline for filing any reply memoranda is February 15, 2007.

d. Memoranda in support of or opposition to any dispositive motions shall not exceed 60 pages in length. Reply memoranda shall not exceed 10 pages in length.

4. The parties shall meet and confer regarding the contents of a joint appendix to be submitted with the filing of the dispositive motions, with each side bearing an equal share of the costs of preparing the appendix. The joint appendix shall contain a single copy of each document to which reference is made in support of either party's dispositive motion. The documents contained in the joint appendix shall be


separately tabbed and sequentially numbered and shall be identified by title and brief description in a table of contents.

5. The provisions of paragraph 2 of the Case Management Plan apply to the filing of the parties' dispositive motions and joint appendix.

6. No other terms set forth in the Case Management Plan, as previously modified, shall be affected by the changes made herein.

7. Any requests for modification or supplementation of this Case Management Order should be received by the Special Master on or before October 20, 2006.
