It has come to our attention that an organization known as Save Passamaquoddy Bay has posted on its website a link to an article that appeared recently in the Gloucester County Times reporting on the February 22, 2007 oral argument scheduled in New Jersey v. Suffice it to say, Mr. Lancaster is not representing FERC in any matter, as a mediator or otherwise. Pierce Atwood does currently represent Downeast LNG, LLC, an entity that is attempting to obtain permits for an LNG facility on land adjacent to Passamaquoddy Bay in the Town of Robbinston in downeast Maine. Neither Mr. Lancaster nor I have been involved in any way in representing Downeast LNG.

If either party believes this requires any discussion or has any questions on the foregoing, the Special Master will be prepared to address the issue during the telephone conference scheduled for December 8, 2006.
