Dear Special Master Myles:

We hereby set forth Joint Progress Report No. 13 from intervenors City of Charlotte, North Carolina (Charlotte), Catawba River Water Supply Project (CRWSP) and Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC (Duke) (collectively, Intervenors).

On March 30, 2009, the Supreme Court issued an order stating that it would hear oral argument on South Carolina's exceptions to the First Interim Report of the Special Master in "due course."

Document discovery in accordance with Case Management Order No.7 is continuing among the parties without any pending disputes requiring judicial assistance. Intervenors anticipate that document discovery and procedural tools to clarify the scope and nature of the harm that South Carolina is alleging and the causes of that harm will continue to occupy the parties until the hearing on South Carolina's exceptions.
