Pursuant to Rules 25.5 and 30.4, Petitioners and Respondents in the above-captioned case jointly request an extension of time within which to file their respective briefs on the merits.

The Writ of Certiorari was granted in this case on May 21, 2018. Petitioners' brief is currently due on July 5, and Respondents' brief is due on August 6. Petitioners request a two-week extension of the deadline for their brief on the merits, to and including July 19, and Respondents request an additional week extension of the deadline for their brief on the merits, to and including August 27. Under this proposed extended schedule, Petitioners' Reply Brief would be due pursuant to Rule 25.3 on September 26, which would preserve the possibility that the case could be scheduled for the first sitting of the Court's October 2018 Term.

These extensions are jointly requested both because of the many professional commitments of both Petitioners' and Respondents' Counsel in other cases, and because of long-scheduled vacation plans, over the summer, by Counsel for both parties.
