Dear Mr. Harris:

The petition for a writ of certiorari in the above-captioned case was filed on January 8, 2018. The response of the United States is now due, after one extension, on April 23, 2018. We respectfully request, under Rule 30.4 of the Rules of this Court, a further extension of time to and including May 22, 2018, within which to file a response.

This extension is necessary because the attorneys with principal responsibility for preparation of the government's response have been heavily engaged with the press of previously assigned matters with proximate due dates. Granting the requested extension would not prevent the Court from acting on the petition during the current Term.
