Dear Mr. Harris:

I am writing on behalf of both petitioners and respondents to update the Court with respect to the settlement proceedings in this case.

On July 30, 2018, the U.S. District Court for the Central District of California granted preliminary approval of the class action settlement in the underlying litigation. Pursuant to the Court's order, notice of the proposed settlement has been distributed to shareholders of record and shareholders have until October 29, 2018 to object or request exclusion from the settlement. The final approval hearing is scheduled for November 19, 2018. Upon final approval of the settlement, the parties will file a joint request to dismiss the petition pursuant to Rule 46(1).

In light of the parties' agreement to settle the pending action and the settlement proceedings in the district court, the parties request that the Court defer action on the pending petition for a writ of certiorari until its conference on December 7, 2018. If the settlement proceedings are still pending, we will provide the Court with a status update no later than November 30, 2018.
