
On July 30, 2018, the U.S. District Court for the Central District of California granted preliminary approval of the class action settlement in the underlying litigation. On November 19, 2018, the District Court conducted a final approval hearing, and on that same day it granted final approval of the settlement and dismissed the case without prejudice. In light of these developments, the petition is moot and should be now dismissed. Each party has agreed to pay its own costs.

We thank the Court for its willingness to defer consideration of the petition while the settlement proceedings were underway.
