
This letter is sent as a request by respondent, the State of Illinois, for an extension of time to file a response to the petition for a writ of certiorari in the above-captioned case. Currently, the response is due on April 9, 2018. I request an extension of 30 days to file the response, until May 9, 2018.

I request this extension because the Assistant Attorney General (AAG) who is responsible for drafting the response to AAG Katherine Doersch, must familiarize herself with the history of the case and the issue presented before beginning to draft the response. In addition, AAG Doersch is currently responsible for drafting a reply brief in *People v. Lesley*, No. 122100 (Ill. Sup. Ct.) (due April 3, 2018), an appellee's brief in *People v. Sadeq*, No. 4-16-0105 (Ill. App. Ct.) (due April 9, 2018), and a response to a habeas corpus petition in *Craig v. Mueller*, No. 18 C 0639 (N.D. Ill.) (due April 28, 2018).

This is respondent's first request for an extension of time. It is not made for the purpose of delay, but solely to insure that respondent's interests are adequately protected.
