I represent petitioners in the above-captioned matter. The Court granted the petition for a writ of certiorari in this case on June 28, 2019. Petitioners' brief on the merits is currently due August 12, 2019.

In order to accommodate scheduling difficulties and the press of other cases, pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 30.4, petitioners respectfully request an extension of time on the briefing schedule in this case. Respondents do not object to that request, provided that respondents are afforded a proportional extension of time to file their brief. The proposed schedule reflects our understanding that the case will be set for oral argument in the January sitting. Under the proposed schedule, the brief of petitioners and the joint appendix would be due September 17, 2019, and the brief of respondents would be due November 22, 2019.
