Dear Justice Ginsburg:

I am a pro se litigant. I plan to file a petition for a writ of certiorari before the US Supreme Court to review *Mira v. Kingston*, which was appealed in the Second Circuit. The case concerns job discrimination, civil rights and other related claims against individual Defendants and Platts/S&P Global.

While the US Court of Appeals concurred that the district court erred in not responding to my request to amend my complaint, it provided no remedy to reverse that error, which was fatal to my case. The US Court of Appeals later declined my petition for a rehearing.

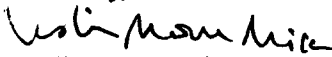
The US Court of Appeals entered its judgment January 12, 2018. I understand that my petition would be due April 11, 2018. A copy of the court's summary order and the entry judgment are enclosed.

I respectfully request a deadline extension up to and including 50 days from that date. An extension will help secure affordable printing options. An inextricably related case against Argus Media is presently before the same Court of Appeals with pending and imminent deadlines. An extension will also help my research on how to properly submit a writ.
