I represent the Petitioners in the above-captioned case, in which the Supreme Court granted certiorari on May 28, 2019.

After conferring with counsel for the Respondent, we jointly move for adoption of the following modified briefing schedule:

Petitioners' Opening Brief:	Friday, August 2, 2019
Respondent's Brief:	Monday, September 23, 2019
Petitioners' Reply Brief:	Wednesday, October 23, 2019

This schedule reflects mutually agreed-upon extensions for both parties, which are necessary due to the heavy press of business for all counsel. It would also allow for the case to be set for argument during the session beginning on Monday, November 4, 2019 (or any later session), consistent with Rule 25.3.

The parties also jointly move to dispense with the printing of the Joint Appendix, as the necessary lower-court materials are already provided in the Petition Appendix. If the Court denies this motion, the parties jointly request in the alternative that the Joint Appendix be due on the same day as the Petitioners' opening brief—per the proposed modified schedule, above.
