

## CERTIFICATION FOR PETITION FOR REHEARING

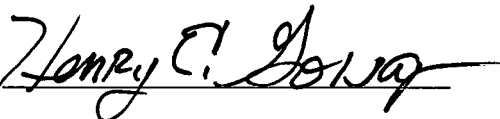
