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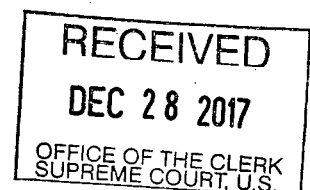


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PETITION FOR REHEARING

Petitioner George Sideris, a self represented litigant, respectfully submits this Petition for Rehearing on December 26, 2017, Order of this Court denying his petition for a writ of certiorari. He attaches the certification required by this Court's Rule 44.2

Mr. Sideris submitted a petition for writ of certiorari concerning his claims of violation of his fifth and sixth amendment rights. Judges, attorneys and civil service commissioners colluded to deny him justice regarding false criminal charges at Essex and Middlesex County Superior Courts, the Massachusetts Appeals Court, The Massachusetts Supreme Judicial Court and the Massachusetts Civil Service Commission. He stated in his motion to amend the judgment against him regarding legal malpractice at Middlesex County Superior Court that the respondent Riley & Dever, P.C. falsified both his amended complaint and memorandum of law in opposition to the motion to dismiss his amended complaint. The respondent altered both the cause of action and the spelling of the petitioner's name at the signatures section of both documents. Then it turned them in with its 9a packet at Middlesex County Superior Court. Judge Henry never had a hearing on the amended complaint. The petitioner had requested a hearing on the amended complaint. This prevented the petitioner from knowing that his amended complaint and memorandum of law in opposition to the motion to dismiss his amended complaint were falsified until after he received the judgment to dismiss the complaint. The petitioner mentioned the

falsifying of these documents and forgery of his signature by misspelling in his motion to amend the judgment. Even though no hearing took place regarding these, the criminal case or the wrongful termination of the petitioner from the Peabody Police Department regarding the criminal charges, the respondent was still culpable.

The petitioner turned in his copy of his amended complaint, memorandum of law in opposition to the motion to dismiss his amended complaint and motion to amend the judgment against him at Middlesex County Superior Court with his appeal brief at the Massachusetts Appeals Court. The petitioner mentioned all of this in his application for further appellate review at the Massachusetts Supreme Judicial Court. This shows the above mentioned judges, attorneys and civil service commissioners had mens rea and actus reus. The petitioner has a bachelor of science degree in criminal justice from Salem State College in Salem, Ma. The motive for the petitioner's accuser's crimes was to deny the petitioner surgery on both knees injured in the line of duty at the Peabody Police Dept. Any logical person would only conclude that these people colluded to deny the petitioner, an innocent person, justice.

CONCLUSION

Once the judges see the fabricated confession, Massachusetts State Police photos and medical

records of the alleged victim in the criminal case, have mandated reporters of elder abuse including Dr. Jean Coumans and Dr. Nathalie Majorek testify along with certified handwriting expert Christine Cusack, they will see the magnitude of corruption in this case and clear the petitioner of any wrongdoing. Only the judges of the Supreme Court of the United States can handle this case at this point.
