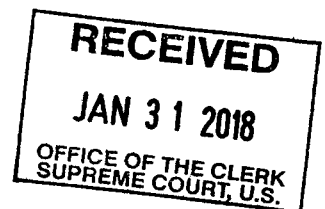

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PETITION FOR REHEARING

This Petition for Writ of Certiorari ("Cert_3") is the third and last of three Petitions docketed in this case. The first Petition for Writ of Certiorari ("Cert_1") which was docketed as 17-5691 was denied in the Order of October 30, 2017 and the Petition for Rehearing for Cert-1 was denied in the Order of December 11, 2017. The second Petition for Writ of Certiorari in this Case ("Cert_2") was docketed as 17-6214. Cert_2 was denied in the Order of December 04, 2017 and the Petition for Rehearing for Cert_2 was denied in the Order of January 22, 2018. This third Petition for Writ of Certiorari in this Case ("Cert_3"), was denied in the Order of January 8, 2018 and this imploring third Petition for Rehearing regarding Cert_3 is respectfully submitted in nervous anticipation of consideration for Justice..

The questions presented in this case are too important to the significance of the Federal Constitution and it's effect on the constitutional rights of Citizens to be overlooked without definitive guidance and ruling from this Court. In the absence of decisive ruling from this Court, recurrence of similar cases are guaranteed to taunt and openly subject law abiding Citizens to undeserved torturous intimidating repression of federally guaranteed constitutional rights. Petitioners thus respectfully request that the Court grants rehearing of this denied Cert_3 with considerations for the denied Petitions in the Prior Orders as to the significant, interdependence of the Petitions regarding the contemptuous disregard of the Federal Constitution in the final Judgment of the lower Courts.

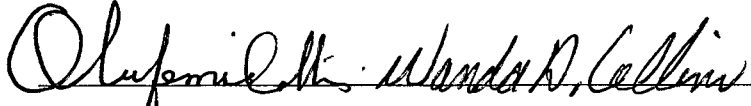

prejudicially granted and affirmed by the Lower Courts and the review of the prejudicial decisions was discretionarily denied by the Supreme Court of California.

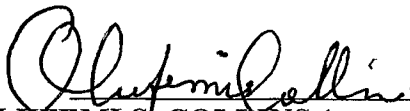
For the foregoing reasons, the petition for rehearing should be granted
