QUESTION PRESENTED

1. Why are Arizona judges preventing an African American from receiving an Amended Default Complaint Judgment against an insurance company by Ruling Arizona Appeals Court does not have Jurisdiction to rule on a civil case from Arizona Superior Court?

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OPINION BELOW

JURISDICTION

The appeal court judges gave their Final Judgment Decision on September 15, 2017, roughly 15 months after they claimed that Arizona Appeals Court did not have Jurisdiction to hear Plaintiff's civil case from Arizona Superior Court. Case # **CV2015-051465**.

CONTITUTION PROVISIONS

U.S. Cont. Amend. XIV, sec. 1:

All persons born or naturalized in the United States and subject to the jurisdiction thereof, are citizens of the United States and of the State wherein they reside. No state shall make or enforce any law which shall abridge the privileges or immunities of citizens of the United States; nor shall any State deprive any person of life, liberty, without due process of law; nor deny to any person within its jurisdiction the equal protection of the law.

STATEMENT OF THE CASE

Petitioner Harrison Willis, received a Default Judgment against Dentists Benefit Insurance company and their lawyer failed to file an appeal in Arizona Superior Court...even after a period of one year.

It was speculated that a sitting judge was a partner at one of the law firms that was representing Defendant, and he used his judge's power to persuade other judges to dismiss plaintiff's Amended Complaint Default Judgment. It is also speculated that he had Arizona Appeals Court judges formulate the lack of Jurisdiction accuses to have to keep the Plaintiff from receiving a favorable ruling in Arizona Appeals Court.

These appeal court judges knows that that 100% of Arizona Superior Court Case are accepted by Arizona Appeals Court or the case is sent back to Arizona Superior.

In the African American situation, Arizona Appeals Court ruled on the African American case for over a year and never sent anything back to Arizona Superior Court.

Court records will prove that Arizona Appeals Court is the only Court to hear appeals from Arizona Superior Court. In other words, if an African American cannot file an appeal in Arizona Appeals Court there are no court available for an African American to file an appeal.

REASON FOR GRANTING THE PETITION

Every judge in the United States knows that every city has a court where a Plaintiff or Defendant can file an appeal timely. Arizona judges refusing to let an African American file an appeal in Arizona Appeals Court is a violation of African Americans Civil Rights.

CONCLUSION

THE PETITION FOR A WRIT OF CERTIORARI SHOULD BE GRANTED AND THE SUPREME COURT OF THE UNITED STATES SHOULD RULE THAT THE PETITIONER SHOULD HAVE THE RIGHTS TO FILE A DEFAULT JUDGMENT IN ARIZONA APPEALS COURT.
