PETITION FOR REHEARING

The Appellant presents this request for a Rehearing on Grounds that in the "Questions Presented" a review by the Court could initiate expediency for a collective national assessment of unresolved violations in Constitutional Law/Articles mandated to protect National Defense.

1. The "Questions Presented" provide linkage to direct evidence of Laws that have been virtually ignored. The purpose and need, aligned with meaning of the Law, is not compensated within protective guidelines. The evidence directly cites misuse in the manner applied, with a lack of oversight on critical security issues not safeguarded. Evidence continues to be compounded in reports and documents compiled by Agencies and Inspector Generals for submittal to Congressional Committees, as scheduled.
2. This Case exposes, at each level of the lower Courts, a consistent redirection of focus from the primary purpose of the Petitioners Whistle Blower filing. Attempting to distract and divert attention away from Agency violations that create grave danger to Law Enforcement Agencies and others. With many years as a specialist and team(s) leader on military sensitive missions. The Petitioner knows only to expect and provide consistency and reliance for the protection of others who depend on secured information in compliance with security classification processes, procedures and protocols.
3. The Questions Presented cite tactics used to mask information through denial of Due Process Rights from the Petitioner and Discovery Request. This Court would reveal such tactics that were communicated in Motions before the lower Court.
4. The Questions Presented provide direct evidence identifying a process of intimidation and collusion using legal tactics lead by a Federal Senior Executive Service Member, a career appointee in the position of Regional Solicitor of the Western Regional States.
5. US National Defense is publicly stated to be the highest priority of our new President. It was promised to voters with a majority approval by US citizens. This Court, with jurisdiction and authority of Merit, has the experience and Constitutional knowledge as the central judicial body to most efficiently initiate a path leading to the correction involving adherence to critical security policies and controlling misuse.
