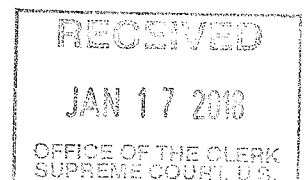
The Petitioner asks for leave to file the attached petition for a writ of certiorari without payment of costs and to proceed *in forma pauperis*.
