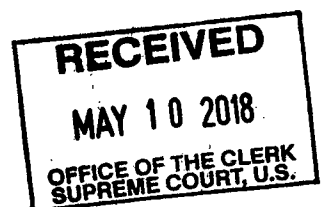

**MOTION TO EXTEND TIME FOR FILING PETITION IN COMPLIANCE
WITH RULE 33.1 OF THE RULES OF THE SUPREME COURT OF THE

SCOTT A. BAGI, Petitioner-Appellant, respectfully requests an extension of Sixty days within which to re-file his petition in compliance with Rule 33.1 of the Rules of the Supreme Court of the United States.

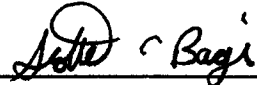
