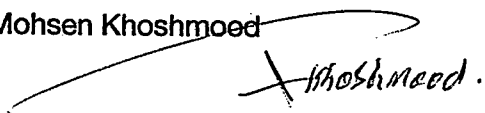

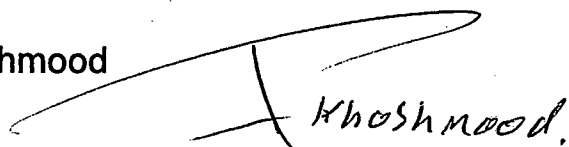

Imagine Where was been housing authority for Cities and state and Federal I applied each year and I did not qualified because I was been single parent keep my family in the street or each time complain there are under the constitution of law attacked and assault and abused case 2012-7290 DC . Imagine how many illegal families got the service from the city and state and federal.

Imagine human resources last 28 years over 23000 jobs I applied more than 20 time Workforce and federal job programs each time full discrimination appeared.

Citizen of USA I believed and support of the constitution and amendment , human rights liberty of USA .

Background, On 1998 I was single parent with 2 kids Foaad Khosmood in 12 great school , Farsheed Khosmood 10 great in middle school I have no job or any income convected from government apartment section 8 and court system with out concerning about my family convected from HUD, government apartment and Marshall take my kids in to the street judge ordered under the religion ,race, discrimination. 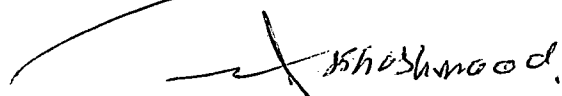

REASONS FOR GRANTING THE PETITION

Supreme Law 28 USC 1291, 28 USC 1252

A court of appeals, however, dismiss the secretary appeal for lack of jurisdiction under 28 USC 1291 on the grounds that direct review could be had in the US supreme court.

Speedy trial Act, 6 amendment right, The speedy trial clause of the sixth amendment to the united state constitution provides that all prosecutions, the accused shall enjoy the right to a speedy trial the clause protects the defendant from delay between the presentation of the indictment or similar charging instrument and the beginning of trial, The speedy a violation of speedy trial clause of dismiss with Attorney General or Government Is prejudice of this case and violate my rights.

In Doggett v, US (1991-1992) the supreme court determined that Doggett's eight and half years wait for a trial violated his six amendment rights the speedy trial clause and they gave him a writ of certiorari .

In Zedner v US 2006 it was determined by the supreme court that a defendant can't waive his right to speedy trial using the speedy trial clause . And attorney general office Washington DC dismiss the case, I had interested all the time to get speedy trial in this case, which impossible waive them by me.

Article 1, 2 freedom information Act vs 42 USC 41 (a)(5)(A)

This case presents an issue of law with wide scale public importance. It brings a long overdue question appearing to have not come to the attention of this Court since the enactment of the 1954 Internal Revenue Code, and, deserves a thoughtful answer. Rarely (if ever) two federal judges agree on the law of a case whenever income tax cases come before them. Whether civil assessment, seizures or injunctions; or when charging jury instructions with the lives and liberties of men and women, whole families, and sometimes community survival is at stake in the case of businesses being shut down. In 1954 Congress rightfully removed all of the mandatory provisions of law in Subtitle A, the income tax with respect to individuals in response to decisions of this Court. It also defined the term "income" for income tax purposes but that definition does not appear in the Internal Revenue Code and it is not being acknowledged in the courts. This Court should find this to be a compelling reason for granting this Petition. The Court should grant this Petition because the justice system, human right, all constitution law and amendment, I think if court system did brooks constitution of law, if I'm pro se the court need to do right things, and put forth a combination of Code Sections and supplanted inside that formula the word "wages" trying to create a liability where no liability is provided by Congress; and, the words "wages" and "liability" appear no where in any of the Code Sections the court used to instruct the jury. The lower courts across this Land are making up various "liability" formulas for takings of monies, properties and liberties from the American People, enacting laws by Court Order on a case by case basis for the Internal Revenue Service, meaning that no one can know what the "law" is until the end of the trial when it is given to the jury or it comes out on a Court Order much too late to avoid the problem. This Petition For Writ of Certiorari should be granted because the Applicant in this case has suffered a severe injustice due to agency failures in administrative procedures and misfeasance of federal prosecutors influencing the courts and jurors with misleading and false statements in violation of constitutional due process protections, finally this is the criminal case of missing my son because lack of service of government.
