COMES NOW, Kenneth Williams, the Petitioner, in pro se respectfully moves this Honorable Court pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 30, for an order extending the time to file a Writ Of Certiorari Motion to the Supreme Court, for the following reasons stated below.

1. On May 5, 2017, the Petitioner filed pro-se a Motion To Recall Mandate Based On Fraud On The Court, to the Eleventh Circuit Court of Appeals. No. 00-13083-GG
2. On June 26, 2017, the Motion To Recall Mandate Based On Fraud On The Court was denied.
3. On July 7, 2017, the Petitioner filed pro-se a Motion For Panel Review Pursuant To Federal Rule Appellate Procedure 27(c).

7. This is the Petitioner first request for an Extension Of Time Motion to file his Writ of Certiorari Motion.

8. The Petitioner currently representing himself pro-se, and he has no training in the field of law and needs the additional time to properly prepare and file his Writ of Certiorari Motion.
9. The Petitioner has an institutional job at USP McGrory federal prison, and he has limited access to the law library. The Petitioner needs additional time to conduct his research, study the applicable case law and properly prepare his Motion For Writ Of Certiorari, pursuant to the Supreme Court Rules.
10. This motion is made in the interest of justice and is not meant to delay the proceedings. The Solicitor General, Attorney General and the Government's Prosecutors, will not be prejudiced by the delay.
