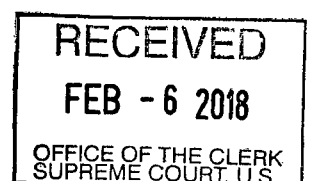

MOTION EXTENSION OF TIME
TO FILE
PETITION FOR A WRIT OF CERTIORARI

The Petitioner respectfully moves this Honorable Court pursuant to Rule 30 Computation and Extension of Time to enter an order extending the time to file his Writ of Certiorari for a period of 30 days. And will show good cause for the following:

1. The Petition for Writ of Certiorari is presently due on or before January 29, 2018.
2. The remaining time for filing is insufficient to insure an adequate presentation because, the Petitioner has been transferred from Wakulla Correctional Institution to Blackwater River Correctional Facility and has been

Furthermore on January 9, 2018 a serious assault on Blackwater Staff occurred and Blackwater River Correctional Facility was placed on lockdown from January 9, 2018 until January 17, 2018. Which further diminish time needed to timely and effectively complete the Writ of Certiorari.

3. All parties has been served a copy of the enclosed Motion for Extension of Time as indicated on the Certificate of Service.

4. Petitioner respectfully moves this Court to extend deadline 30 days from January 29, 2018. To file his Writ of Certiorari.

5. This motion is filed in good faith and not to delay the appellate process.

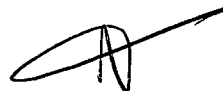
WHEREFORE, Petitioner prays for the relief herein requested.

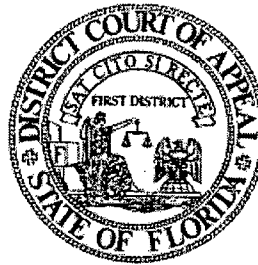

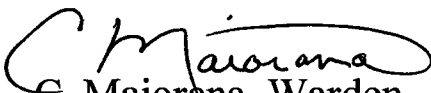

Staff will be tasked over the upcoming days to accomplish numerous assignments. I encourage you to do as directed in order for us to accomplish this.

- Your cells and bunk areas must remain in order throughout this lockdown.
- Showers will begin tomorrow (Friday). Once showers are announced I encourage you be ready to go, your shower time will be limited.
- You will receive one hot meal per day.
- Trash pickup will be several times throughout the day, DO NOT accumulate trash in your cell.
- Cloth-line will not be tolerated.
- Weekend visitation (Saturday, Sunday and Monday) will be canceled.
- You will be given a chance to notify your family of the cancellation over the next two days.

Again, I cannot express the importance of your cooperation over the next few days.
