These appeals have been filed from an order appointing a master. There is no indication that a final order of equitable distribution has been entered. In the absence of a final order, the order is interlocutory and unappealable pursuant to ***Fried v. Fried***, 599 Pa. 89, 501 A.2d 211 (1985) (noting disapproval of collateral order doctrine in divorce cases) and ***West v. West***, 446 A.2d 1342 (Pa. Super. 1982)(holding that order which anticipates further proceedings is interlocutory and unappealable). Therefore, the appeals are hereby **QUASHED**, *sua sponte*. The June 26, 2017 **"Application for Emergency Relief"** filed at 829 WDA 2017 is **DISMISSED** as moot.

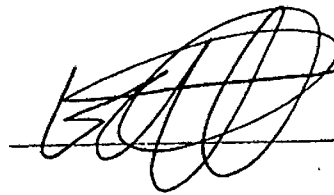

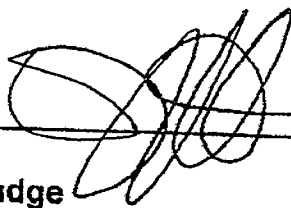
