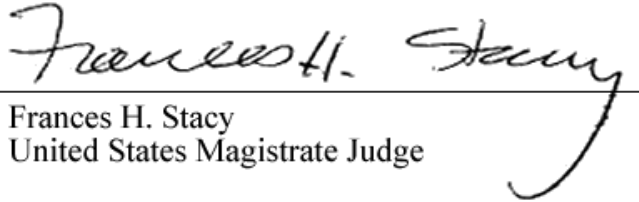
ORDER APPOINTING COUNSEL
