MOTION FOR LEAVE TO PROCEED *IN FORMA PAUPERIS*

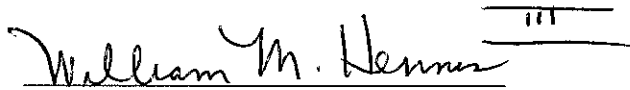
Capital Case
