Appellant Royal Porter McHenry filed a Notice of Appeal on April 25, 2017 in the above-entitled matter seeking review of an order denying a Motion to Vacate Judgment entered on February 9, 2017 and Court orders entered on June 23, 2016 and December 12, 2016.

Appellant was declared to be a Vexatious Litigant and an Order and Prefiling Order pursuant to Code of Civil Procedure § 391.7 were entered on March 28, 2016 by the Los Angeles Superior Court in case number BC584138.

This Court issued a Notice to Parties on May 9, 2017 directing Appellant to show cause in writing why this Appeal had merit and was not taken for purposes of harassment or delay. Appellant's Responses were received and filed on May 11, 2017. No Response or opposition has been received from the Respondent.

The Court has read and considered Appellant's Responses and the available record. The Court finds that Appellant has failed to meet the burden of showing that this appeal has merit.

The request for a prefiling order is denied. The Notice of Appeal in the above-entitled matter filed April 25, 2017 is hereby dismissed, on the Court's own motion, pursuant to Code of Civil Procedure § 391.7(c).
