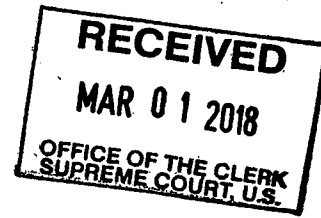

Dear clerk: Request for sixty days extension of time to file certiorari

TO: THE HONORABLE SUPREME COURT OF THE UNITED STATES

Petitioner is proper person in the above-entitled case. Petitioner received an order from Minnesota Supreme Court denying review. Petitioner is required to file a writ of certiorari within ninety (90) days from November 28, 2017, order, making his petition due February 28, 2018. Petitioner respectfully requests an additional two months to file a writ, which would extend the time to May 1, 2018.

The extension is necessary because:

1. I, Oji K. Markham, Petitioner in this case, have been working diligently on this writ of certiorari. In spite of my efforts to file a timely petition in this case, I am unable to complete this by February 28, 2018. Petitioner case involves multiple issues and includes a voluminous trial transcript.
