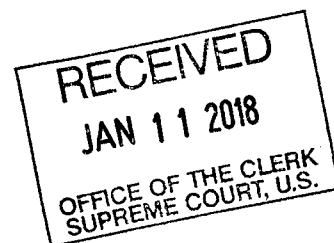

MR. VERNON'S MOTION REQUESTING 60 ADDITIONAL DAYS
TO FILE HIS MOTION FOR WRIT OF CERTIORARI

Mr. Vernon was denied his application for a certificate of appealability with the United States Court of Appeals for the Eleventh Circuit. He has 90 days to file for a writ of certiorari and now requests 60 additional days to do so.

Mr. Vernon is incarcerated at FCI Coleman Low and has been assisted with his legal filing by another inmate named Frank L. Amodeo. This prison is under a partial lockdown due to a quarantine for the chicken pox virus, and Mr. Vernon is unable to speak with or interact with Mr. Amodeo. The quarantine is expected to lift within the next 21 days and then Mr. Amodeo and Mr. Vernon will be able to work towards a proper filing of a writ of certiorari.

As such, Mr. Vernon requests an additional 60 days in order to overcome the obstacles the quarantine presents that hinder an otherwise earlier filing.
