This action came before the Honorable Louise W. Flanagan, United States District Judge, for hearing upon petitioner's certification that respondent is a sexually dangerous person pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 4248.

IT IS ORDERED AND ADJUDGED upon clear and convincing evidence that respondent Anthony Raymond Lesch is a sexually dangerous person. The court commits respondent to the custody of the Attorney General pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 4248 until the director of the facility in which respondent is placed certifies that respondent's condition is such that he is no longer sexually dangerous to others, or will not be sexually dangerous to others if released under a prescribed regimen of medical, psychiatrist, or psychological care or treatment and the court orders his discharge.
