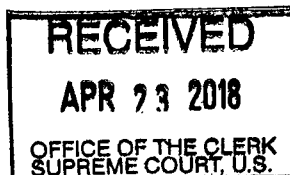

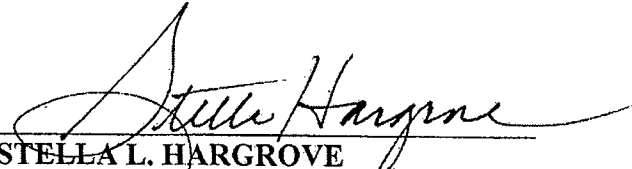
ORDER

This cause came to be heard on the 3rd day of June, 2016, before the Hon. Stella L.

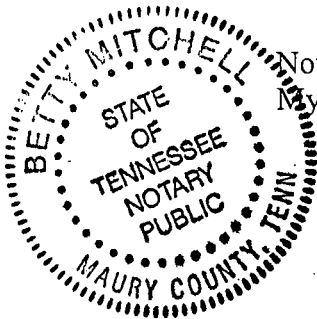
