Dear Mr. Harris:

This letter is sent as a request by respondent the People of the State of Illinois for a second extension of time to file a response to the petition for a writ of certiorari in the above-captioned case. Currently, the response is due on October 12, 2018. I request an extension of 28 days to file the response, until November 9, 2018.

This extension is necessary for the assigned Assistant Attorney General, Retha Stotts, to complete her review of the extensive record, including the electronic recording of petitioner's custodial interview; complete her research of the issues presented by petitioner; and finalize her response and submit it for supervisory review. In addition, Ms. Stotts is currently responsible for filing a response to a motion for leave to file a petition for an original writ of mandamus in *Bahrs v. Pavlus*, No. M.D. 14162 (Ill.), and attending an October 5, 2018 hearing in *Racanelli v. Ashby*, No. 18 MR 715 (Lake Cty. Ill.). And, as a supervising attorney in the Criminal Appeals Division, Ms. Stotts is responsible for reviewing and editing on a

daily basis numerous pleadings filed in state and federal court by attorneys in the division.

This is respondent's second request for an extension of time. It is not made for the purpose of delay, but solely to insure that respondent's interests are adequately protected. Because the petitioner is in custody, I have been unable to determine whether he agrees to this request.
