To The Eleventh Circuit Court of Appeals

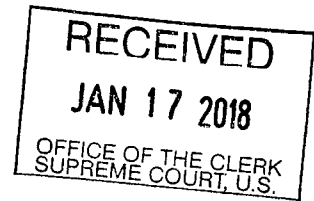
