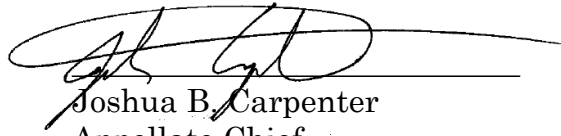
U.S. District Court for the Western District of North Carolina, Case No. 1:16-CR-41, by oral order dated August 31, 2016.
